

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the www.centralmdbaseball.com, profiles.centralmdbaseball.com, and Central Maryland Baseball Academy, LLC and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Central Maryland Baseball Academy, LLC include www.centralmdbaseball.com, CMBA, Revolution Baseball, LLC and www.centralmdbaseball.com. The CMBA website is a Baseball player statistics and information site. By using the CMBA website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

CMBA may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. CMBA may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your age, gender and associated schools and baseball leagues. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by CMBA. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the CMBA website.

CMBA encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from CMBA so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. CMBA is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the CMBA website.

Use of your Personal Information

CMBA collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

CMBA may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from CMBA and its affiliates. CMBA may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

CMBA does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

CMBA may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to CMBA, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

CMBA will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on CMBA or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or

property of CMBA; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of CMBA, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The CMBA website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.
